



ROUTE MARSHALS (YORKSHIRE WIDE)

You will be designated a location on the race route, assisting in the safe passage of the riders and race vehicles. Unless you have been a Tour de Yorkshire Tour Maker in 2019 you will need to attend a half-day mandatory training session approximately two months prior to the Championships. You are expected to find your own way to your start position and will be outside for most of the event

- **Spectator Engagement:** *Spectator Engagement volunteers will be based together in small groups at key points along the route. They will act as the face of the race, welcoming and offering advice and support to spectators, whilst making sure the crowds do not cause a risk to the riders or the event. Duties may also include supporting the Yorkshire 2019 team with activation and distributing giveaways.*

Supervisors and Deputy Supervisor: *Supervisors are responsible for the group of spectator engagement volunteers based in each location, ensuring they are deployed appropriately across their allocated area and have all the information they need.*

- **Junction Supervisors:** *Junction Supervisors will work alongside traffic management companies and be based at key junctions along the race route where closures are necessary. Their role will be to support the road closure and alert road users of the passage of the race and redirection, whilst also identifying any marked cars that may be of risk and engage with spectators giving any relevant information.*
- **Flag and Whistle Marshals:** *will ensure the safety of the riders by physically indicating hazards and structure causing a risk of collision - this includes road islands and street furniture.*
